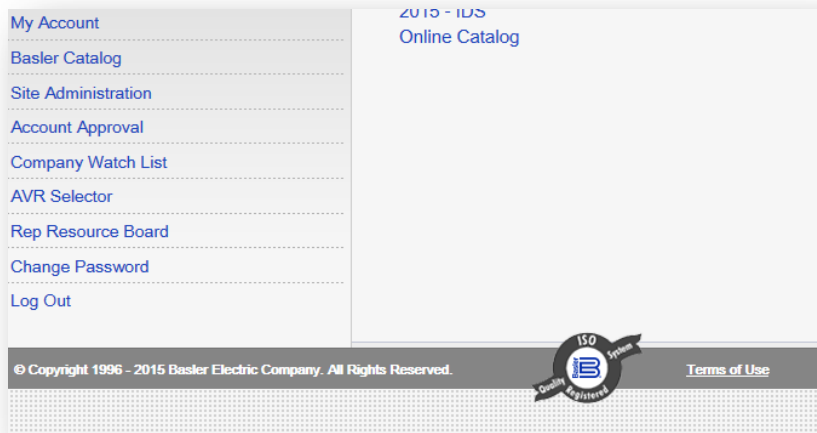


# Basler Electric 2016 Online Power Systems Catalog

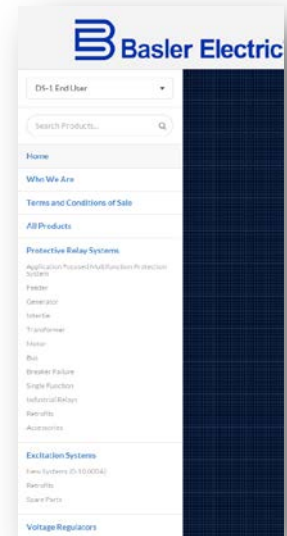
## Accessing the catalog

1. To access the 2016 online catalog, navigate to [www.basler.com](http://www.basler.com) and log in using your username and password.
2. From the My Account page, click on “Basler Catalog” on the left side navigation menu.
3. Click on “Online Catalog”.

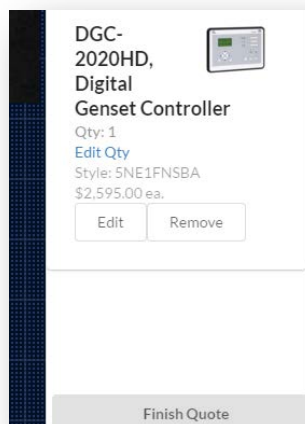


## Navigation

1. Most navigation takes place directly from the left sidebar menu. This menu will display several links to informational pages as well as several methods of navigating to a product page.
  - a. Home – Main page of the catalog
  - b. Who We Are – Summary of Basler Electric and our core purpose and core values
  - c. Terms and Conditions of Sale – Basler’s Form No. FA100001 (Terms and Conditions of Sale).
  - d. Product Category Links – These navigate to pages containing products listed under the chosen category.
  - e. Search Quotes – Search for and retrieve quotes you have previously created .
  - f. Log Off
2. Quote Summary – While on any page, except the final quote details page, you can view your quote summary by clicking on the top right toggle button to expand your right sidebar quote summary. This button will always display how many items are currently listed in your quote summary.

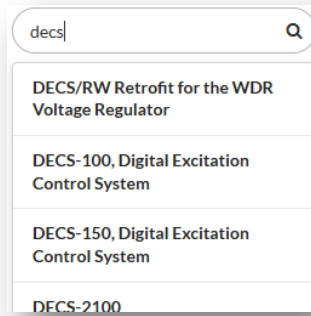


3. Quote Details – From your right sidebar quote summary, you can click on “Finish Quote” at the bottom to navigate to the final quote details page.



## Finding a product

1. You can find a catalog product via three different methods
  - a. Search – The top of your left sidebar navigation menu includes a live search. As you type in the model name of the product, the top ten results will appear under the input. Once you see the product you are looking for, click on the name to navigate to the product’s catalog page. Search results are found by first displaying products that **BEGIN WITH** your query, then products that **CONTAIN** your query in alphabetical order.



- b. View All Product Listing – In the left sidebar navigation menu, click on “All Products” to view a Table of Contents style list of all products grouped by top level category and sorted by model number. Click on the model name of a product to access its catalog page.
    - c. View products for a category – In the left sidebar navigation menu, click on a category or sub-category to view all products listed under that application. Once you have found the product you are looking for, click on the picture or name to navigate to the product’s catalog page.

## Product catalog page

1. Once you have found and clicked on your desired product, you will be on the product's catalog page.

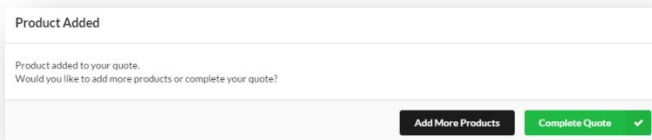
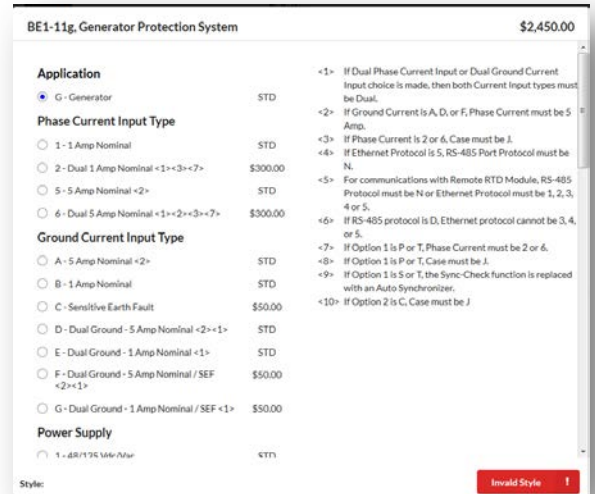

## Quoting a product

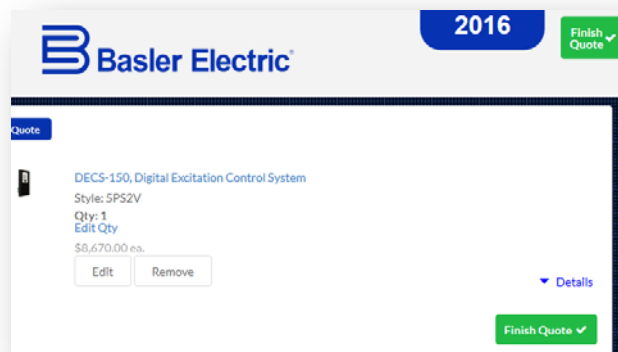
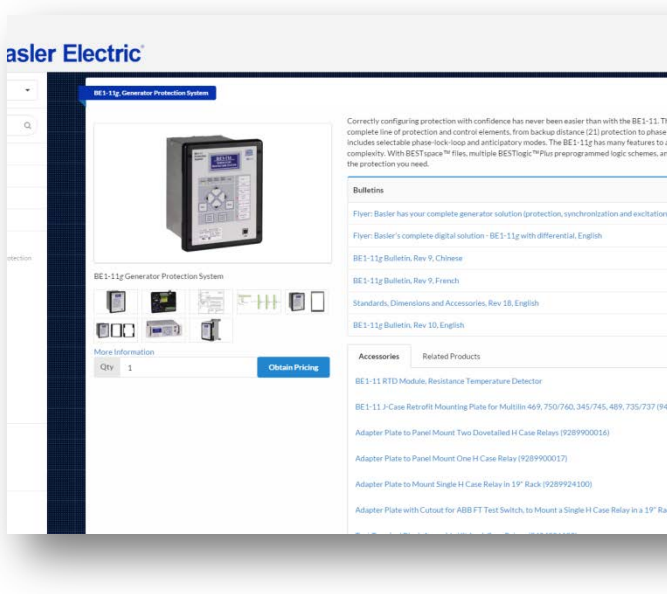
1. Once you are on a product's catalog page, you can obtain pricing by entering a quantity and clicking on the "Obtain Pricing" button located under the pictures.



2. This will bring up a builder window that includes the notes on the right side and all style choices on the left side.
3. As you make style selections, the top right will display the updated price, while the bottom left will display the style number of the selections.
4. The bottom right button will be red and display "Invalid Style!" until a variation under each style has been chosen. Once the button turns green, the style number and price are valid and the item can be added to your quote by clicking the green "Add" button.
5. Once you have added a product to your quote, you will see a confirmation display on your screen with the options to either add more products or complete your quote



- Your item can be viewed, edited, or removed from your right sidebar quote summary or the final quote details page before completing your quote.



### Completing a quote

- From the right sidebar quote summary, click on the “Finish Quote” button located below your quote summary. This will navigate you to the final quote details page.
- From this page, you can view the products added to your current quote, click “Details” to view the selections made, edit the quantity, edit the styles options, remove a quoted product, or complete the quote using the green button located at the bottom of the summary or top right of the page.
- There is one option you can perform prior to completing a quote.
  - Add a Project Reference – By default, the project reference field on the quote PDF will be left blank. If you include a project reference name or number, it will appear in that location on the quote PDF. Simply type in the value and then perform one of the three quote completion options.
- There are three options to complete your quote. You can perform these options as many times as you wish for a quote. Performing any of these actions will “complete” your quote. Completed quotes can no longer be edited or altered in any way, but they can be re-exported, emailed, etc. until a new quote is started.
  - Email a quote – To email a quote, enter the recipient’s email address in the field labeled “Email Address” and click on “Send.” The field will be prepopulated with your account’s email address. If the address changed, a copy of the quote will also be sent to your account’s email address.
  - Export a quote – To export a quote, click on “Export.” You will be prompted to download or view a PDF of your quote.
